Full Dutch course in Terneuzen, Netherlands

You will start working as soon as you finish the Dutch course and before your registration. In this role as a VIG (Verzorgende IG) you will be responsible for providing personal care, guidance, and basic nursing support to patients in both intramural (residential care facilities) and extramural (home care) settings. This also includes the following:

Personal Care:

- Assist with daily activities such as washing, dressing, eating and drinking.
- Support mobility, including helping clients get up, sit down or move safely.
- Encourage and promote client independence.

Nursing Duties:

- Perform basic nursing procedures, including medication administration, wound care, catheter care and injections.
- Monitor, identify, and report any changes in the client's physical and mental health.
- Assist with medical devices and ensure adherence to care plans.

Client Support & Well-Being:

- Provide psychosocial support to clients and their families.
- Create a safe, comfortable, and supportive living environment.
- Facilitate activities that enhance the client's quality of life.

Administration & Reporting:

- Maintain accurate care records and document observations in client files.
- Communicate with other healthcare providers regarding client progress and needs.

Collaboration & Professional Development:

- Work closely with nurses, doctors, physiotherapists, and other healthcare professionals.
- Actively participate in care discussions and contribute to improving care processes.

After the BIG registration, you will be able to work as a Registered Nurse in the Netherlands and receive more responsibilities and higher salary. Depending on your progress, this could be within 12 months.

SALARY:

- €2.643,39 to € 3.471,46 gross salary before BIG registration and € 3.384,01 to €4.102,25 gross salary after (depending on proven experience)
